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What else do we need to know to make your child's experience a most rewarding one?

Payments: A non refundable deposit of \$100 and a registration form for each Camper is required at the time of registration. Checks should be made payable to Sunnybrook Equestrian Center and placed in the payment box in the barn or mailed to the stable. The registration deadline for each camp is the first of the month preceding the month in which each camp is held (i.e. May 1st for June camps, June 1st for July camps, and July 1st for August camps). Final payment will be due by the registration deadline. Camps can be filled well in advance of their deadlines. Registrations will be accepted in the order in which they are received. A \$35 return check fee will be charged on all returned checks. So that we do not worry about your child, it will be very much appreciated if you notify us of any absences – anticipated or otherwise.

Payment agreement (Please read and initial)

_____ I understand that the non-refundable deposit is required for each child and must be included with the completed registration form. I understand that my child will not be able to attend any session where there is an outstanding balance. I understand that I am responsible for any difference in amounts paid by third-parties (Summer Champs, etc) and I also understand that I am responsible for the deposit, which will be reimbursed to me once the balance is paid in full to Sunnybrook Equestrian Center by the third party.

Summer Champs Participants

_____ My child is part of the Summer Champs program with the United Way of Portland and the Portland Public Schools. I have enclosed my \$100 per session deposit. I understand that it is my responsibility to cover any fees remaining after the Summer Champs payment to Sunnybrook Equestrian Center prior to my child's session. I also understand that any refunds will be made once Sunnybrook Equestrian Center has been paid in full by the Summer Champs program.

Cancellations: No cash refunds will be made in the event of cancellation for any reason. You may be able to transfer your credits to another week, to another person, or to traditional riding lessons -- if we are notified of your change in plans prior to the registration deadline or if the cancellation is of an emergency nature. Transfer of credits will be on a weekly basis only and not for daily absences.

What To Bring: A separate list of items will be provided to each student prior to the start of camp.

Warning: I recognize the inherent risks of injury involved in any type of horseback riding generally and in learning to ride in particular. In taking lessons at Sunnybrook Equestrian Center, I assume any such risk of injury and further, I voluntarily release Sunnybrook Equestrian Center, its instructors and agents from any responsibility of any injury I or my child or ward may sustain while receiving instruction or while riding in connection therewith, and I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Sunnybrook Equestrian Center, its instructors and agents of any such claim. I have reviewed and understand the content of Maine's Equine Professional Limited Liability Law. Additionally, I accept full responsibility for friends and visitors accompanying myself on Sunnybrook Equestrian Center property. Under law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

I understand that Sunnybrook Equestrian Center reserves the right to substitute a riding instructor or Barn Manager in the event that their regularly scheduled riding instructor is unable to be present at camp. I understand that the Riding Instructor or Barn Manager may change the material in the program at any time.

I understand that as a student in Sunnybrook Equestrian Center camp program that I may choose to ride a horse of my own or one of the program horses. Stable horses will be used for all hands-on work for non-mounted lessons.

I understand that proper attire must be worn for riding lessons, which is to be pants, shirt, boots with at least a half-inch heel, and an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet that fits properly with an attached harness. Students should provide their own helmet. A rider must wear a helmet at all times when mounted on the horse. We have helmets available for use in the event the student forgets their helmet or does not own one. Half chaps are recommended for advanced beginners.

I understand that all mounted and un-mounted meetings will take place outdoor, in the indoor arena and in the barn. Please bring appropriate clothing.

I, the undersigned, have read and understand the above contract, which I agree to abide by in total, and I have received a copy of this contract. I further understand that if any of the Sunnybrook Equestrian Center's policies or rules are not followed that Sunnybrook Equestrian Center has the right to cancel this contract in full without any refund of money.

Attorney Fees: In any litigation, arbitration, or other proceeding by which one party either seeks to enforce its rights under this Agreement (whether in contract, tort, or both) or seeks a declaration of any rights or obligations under this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be awarded its reasonable attorney fees, and costs and expenses incurred.
